„The Moral Theory of Lawrence Kohlberg“

Abstract: Lawrence Kohlberg developed one of the best-known theories exploring how do people build their moral developments. His work modified and expanded upon Jean Piaget's previous work of moral development theory which was more on explaining how children develop moral reasoning. Kohlberg's theory has been influential in the field of moral psychology, and it has been used to study moral development in various contexts, including education and parenting. However, it has also been subject to criticism, including concerns about cultural bias and the omission of moral emotions and intuition in moral reasoning.

„Lawrence Kohlberg's Stages of Moral Development“

Abstract: In the lecture we will focus on Kohlberg's Stages of Moral Development. According to Kohlberg there are six stages of moral development grouped into three main levels: pre-conventional, conventional, and post-conventional morality. Each stage represents a different way of thinking about moral issues and reflects an individual's level of cognitive and moral development. Kohlberg's theory emphasizes the importance of reasoning and thinking processes in moral decision-making and suggests that individuals may differ in their level of moral development depending on their exposure to moral dilemmas and their cognitive abilities.
